
Please find enclosed some information about the search for Mr. Wallenberg.

It was nice meeting you this week and I hope you are feeling better. I would also like to thank you for introducing me to Mr. Amikam Evenchen.

Mr. Evenchen suggested to me the establishing of a special government fund, whereby moneys would be available to cover expenses incurred in the search for Raoul. He also suggested an international letter writing campaign by members of Parliaments of different countries, as well as other VIPs. His last suggestion was to develop a special item for collectors with reference to Raoul's humanitarian deeds (such as a coin, statue, etc.).

Personally, I think that a special government fund is viable, when it is for educational purposes. It is an excellent idea to start a letter writing campaign, but I suggest that such a campaign should be headed by a special committee at Members of the Knesset.

The following questions are now up for consideration:

- 1) Will Israel sponsor a meeting of Ambassadors stationed in Israel regarding his fate?
- 2) Will Israel invite Raoul Wallenberg's co-worker, his half brother and half sister, and members of the Royal Swedish family to this meeting?
- 3) Will Israel appoint a special high level mission to Moscow to discover his fate?

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- 4) Will Prof. Shevach Weiss allow the formation of a special parliamentary committee on Wallenberg, whereby I suggest that you become the Chairperson of such a committee.
- 5) Will the Knesset approve the establishment of a special fund to develop an educational curriculum on Raoul Wallenberg, to encourage students learning about the altruistic personality of Raoul.

As we now are working so closely together, I would like to inform you that over the last year, I have been in contact with the following Israeli dignitaries (Government, Sochnut and Yad Vashem), in alphabetical order:
