
I wish to thank you for your communication of 3rd August 1992, sent by fax from the EC Delegation in Israel, in which you kindly call my attention to the 80th birthday on 4th August of the missing Raoul Wallenberg and enclose a news release for publicity in the EC member countries to help throw new light on his case.

The European Parliament Resolution on the fate of Raoul Wallenberg and his driver, Vilmos Langfelder, in the EP session document B 3-936/90 of 10 May 1990, as you refer to in your letter, and the decision set out in the Official Journal of the European Communities No C 149/142 of 18 June 1990, denote the concern and support of the European Parliament for your efforts.

I will endeavour to continue to pursue this commitment in recognition and appreciation of the important humanitarian role of Raoul Wallenberg and with deep respect for what he stood for.

Your proposal for an honorary citizenship of the European Communities for Mr Wallenberg is very interesting and will be looked into and discussed together with the European Commission.
